A second and final public hearing for the Town of Talala's Project #18862 CDBG/REAP 22's Wastewater Collection and Treatment Plant Improvement Project will be held on July 14, 2026, at 5:00 P.M. at the Talala Town Hall, 102 W. Watova Street, Talala, OK. The purpose of this public hearing is to provide the citizens of Talala an opportunity to receive information on the Town's performance in implementing the Oklahoma Department of Commerce Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).

Federal/Oklahoma Department of Commerce's funds of \$136,363.63 was awarded and \$136,363.63 was spent. Additionally, other non-federal funds of approximately \$327,766.70 was spent for a total cost of approximately \$464,130.33 for the Wastewater Improvement Project. Approximately 92 households/325 individuals benefited from this project.

This public hearing is open to all citizens of Talala. You are urged to attend and provide your comments on the Town's performance regarding the implementation of the above-named project. Written comments should be sent to Town Clerk, 102 W. Watova Street, Talala, OK 74080 prior to the above date.
